

Frassati Catholic Academy Out of Uniform Day Policy

The principal will announce various out of uniform days. The administration or teacher has the discretion to ask a student who is wearing something unacceptable to change.

The following items are NOT allowed and warrant a school dress code violation:

- Shirts with obscene slogans or logos, violence, sexual innuendos, alcohol, rock groups (even just the name), tobacco ads, or fishnet or crop tops.
- Jewelry that draws attention or distracts from class
- Temporary or permanent tattoos
- Wallet chains
- Pants, shorts, or tops that are skin tight or are shorter than the end of the fingertips when arms are at the side
- Tank tops/midriffs/spaghetti straps/tube tops/halter tops/low cut, sleeveless or backless apparel/garments which allow exposure of torso or shoulders
- Pajama pants
- Oversized pant/or pull-away athletic pants (snaps down the sides)
- Skateboards, roller blades, or shoe skates are not allowed on school property
- Shoes with lights or wheels
- Sandals or open-toed shoes
- Boots of any kind (including fashion boots) cannot be worn in school.

NOTE: Leggings, sweatpants, and joggers will be permitted as long as they do not violate any of the other rules on the list.

NOTE: Snow boots may be worn to school and outside at recess on snowy days, but may not be worn during class. Students should bring shoes to change into or keep shoes they can change into at school in their lockers.
